



Project Background

- 6,564 linear feet of 6-inch to 12-inch diameter new water main
- Extends from Washington Ave. to Rolling Road
- New installation is intended to upgrade water infrastructure in the area
- Project being completed in coordination with Baltimore City and Maryland State Highway Administration



Key Points



- Work to be performed primarily at night between the hours of 9pm and 5am. SHA certified Traffic Control will be present
- Work areas may have steel plates or temporary patches in daytime hours
- Brief (majority around 1-2 hours) water interruptions may be experienced during tie-ins of the new line to the active system. A few tie-ins to the larger main will require longer outages, all during nighttime hours.
- All service interruptions are coordinated through Baltimore City and performed at night
- Advance notice to be provided to all businesses and residents that are to be impacted

Timeline

- Construction scheduled to begin March/April 2024; supply chain dependent
- Expected construction duration of 1 year barring weather delays, etc.
- Roads to be repaired per SHA requirements





Summary



New water main installed along Liberty Road from Washington Ave. to Rolling Road

Work to be performed primarily at night (9p-5a). Plates may be present during daytime.

Roads repaired after completion

Expected construction duration of approx. 1 year
